OUR FAITH

We are a Church of England school, which makes this a very special place to be, but we do welcome children from all other faiths who are in support of our Mission Statement. Our faith permeates the life of the school and shows itself in the way the whole community treats and respects each other. We celebrate mass regularly and prepare the children for First Holy Communion. Collective Worship is taken very seriously in school, and is designed to encourage the whole school community to understand and embed Christian virtues within daily living. Pupils and staff work together to devise and offer worship both in school and in our parish church. Our parish priest is a regular visitor to the school and is also a Governor with responsibility for overseeing the R E curriculum. The children show respect and reverence during all worship times which develops them as particular individuals and makes their faith the foundation for their lives.
